

Allegheny County COVID-19 Testing

Please Note: Starting November 23, Curative - the COVID-19 testing company working with Federally Qualified Health Centers and at the McKeesport site - will begin accepting and billing insurance for the cost of COVID-19 tests. The tests will still be available at no cost, even if a person does not have insurance or has insurance that will not cover the cost of a test. Collecting insurance information and billing insurance when applicable will allow the Allegheny County Health Department, which has covered the cost of Curative tests for months using CARES Act dollars, to continue to provide this service. To accommodate this change, there will not be tests available without an appointment. Please use the online registration system to sign up for a testing slot. Due to the demand, there may be a longer than normal wait to be tested.

General Information on the McKeesport Testing Site

The McKeesport COVID-19 testing site at 455 Industry Road in McKeesport is open from 9 am to 5 pm Monday through Friday by appointment only. The site will be open Saturdays from 9 am to 5 pm starting December 12. The site will be closed Christmas Day (December 25) and New Year's Day (January 1).

It is a drive-thru site utilizing self-administered tests. Those who are unable to drive to the site can contact the COVID-19 Hotline at 1-888-856-2774 or 2-1-1 for additional options and resources.

The site uses both nasal and oral swab tests. The following videos show how to self-administer tests that will be in use at the site.

Make an Appointment

Appointments can be scheduled through the [online registration site](#).

Registering online is fast and easy, and you will be able to select the date and time of your appointment. You will be asked to provide an email address or mobile phone where test results can be sent.

If you have questions about your appointment, about using the online registration site, or if it has been more than 48 hours since you were tested and you have not received your results, please call the Curative testing support line at 1-888-702-9042.

To make an appointment by phone call 412-209-2262 (Hours are Monday-Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm). Please be prepared to provide an email address or mobile phone number where test results can be sent.

You do not need a doctor's referral or prescription for a test. The test will be provided at no cost to you. Insurance is not required. However, if you have insurance, and it covers the cost of the test, your insurance will be billed.

COVID-19 Testing Available at Community Health Clinics in Allegheny County

PITTSBURGH – Testing for COVID-19 is now available at federally qualified health centers in Allegheny County and through Pittsburgh Mercy, a certified community behavioral health clinic.

The tests will be offered at no charge, and patients do not need a doctor's referral. Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 should get tested.

Symptoms include: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat and new loss of taste or smell. This is not a list of all possible symptoms. Other less common symptoms have been reported, including gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.
